From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Last week I wrote about the effort on the part of some within the Catholic Church to “update” the Faith to make it more acceptable to modern man. The first efforts in this area were made in the realm of the Church’s dogmatic teaching by trying to remove the supernatural from the faith. More recently these efforts have targeted the Church’s moral teaching and sought to undermine them by neglecting hard teachings, speaking ambiguously, or simply teaching error (*Veritatis Splendor*, 30).

One of the ways that error has crept in is by attributing the goodness or evil of an action to a person’s intention alone. Willful human action is made up of three elements: the thing done, the person’s intention, and any circumstances that may be involved. For the act to be good, all three have to be good. It is not enough to have a good intention if the thing done is itself bad. The truth that has been neglected is that certain acts are evil in themselves (for example: lying, murder, adultery, abortion, contraception, blasphemy, etc), and can never be made good by our intentions or the circumstances involved.

A second tactic of those trying to change the Church’s moral teaching is by changing the idea of “conscience.” Traditionally, conscience was not a separate part of man, but an act of his intellect whereby he applies his knowledge of moral truths to a particular action that he is going to do or has already done. The intellect then uses this knowledge of moral truth to make a judgment about past actions or about whether the act we are going to do is something good that should be done or evil that should be avoided. Conscience thus warned man against committing some evil action and ‘stung’ him for past sins committed.

The modern attempt to redefine conscience seeks to make a man’s conscience the source of moral truth, meaning that his conscience can decide whether something is right or wrong on its own (cf. *VS* 32). This is simply an error, we are not able to determine what is good or evil on our own; if we were, then there would be no standard of moral truth as each person would have his own standard. Commenting on the words of Genesis 2:16-17: “The Lord God commanded the man, saying, ‘You may eat freely of every tree of the garden; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall die’”, Pope St. John Paul II states that “Revelation teaches that *the power to decide what is good and what is evil does not belong to man, but to God alone*” (*VS* 35). Our conscience does not determine good or evil, it applies the knowledge of good and evil to particular actions.

“Forming one’s conscience” takes place by conforming one’s intellect to the moral truths that are known naturally and those that are Divinely revealed. The Catholic Church teaches moral truths as part of Her mission to save souls since, as a result of sin and concupiscence, our understanding of right and wrong can be damaged and warped. The Church’s moral teaching then is an act of charity in pointing out the “good [we] must do to have eternal life” (Mt. 19:16) and the evil we should avoid.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

La semana pasada escribí sobre el esfuerzo de algunos dentro de la Iglesia Católica para “actualizar” la Fe para hacerla más aceptable para el hombre moderno. Los primeros esfuerzos en esta área se hicieron en el ámbito de la enseñanza dogmática de la Iglesia, tratando de eliminar lo sobrenatural de la fe. Más recientemente, estos esfuerzos se han dirigido a las enseñanzas morales de la Iglesia y han tratado de socavarlas descuidando enseñanzas duras, hablando de manera ambigua o simplemente enseñando errores (*Veritatis Splendor*, 30).

Una de las formas en que se ha infiltrado el error es atribuyendo la bondad o la maldad de una acción únicamente a la intención de una persona. La acción humana voluntaria se compone de tres elementos: la cosa hecha, la intención de la persona y las circunstancias que puedan estar involucradas. Para que el acto sea bueno, los tres tienen que ser buenos. No basta tener una buena intención si lo que se hace es en sí mismo malo. La verdad que se ha descuidado es que ciertos actos son malos en sí mismos (por ejemplo: mentir, asesinar, adulterio, aborto, anticoncepción, blasfemia, etc.) y nunca podrán ser reparados por nuestras intenciones o las circunstancias involucradas.

Una segunda táctica de quienes intentan cambiar la enseñanza moral de la Iglesia es cambiar la idea de "conciencia". Tradicionalmente, la conciencia no era una parte separada del hombre, sino un acto de su intelecto mediante el cual aplica su conocimiento de las verdades morales a una acción particular que va a realizar o que ya ha realizado. Luego, el intelecto utiliza este conocimiento de la verdad moral para emitir un juicio sobre acciones pasadas o sobre si el acto que vamos a realizar es algo bueno que se debe hacer o algo malo que se debe evitar. De este modo, la conciencia advertía al hombre contra la comisión de alguna acción mala y le "picaba" por los pecados cometidos en el pasado.

El intento moderno de redefinir la conciencia busca hacer de la conciencia del hombre la fuente de la verdad moral, lo que significa que su conciencia puede decidir por sí sola si algo está bien o mal (cf. VS 32). Esto es simplemente un error, no somos capaces de determinar por nosotros mismos qué es el bien o el mal; si lo fuéramos, entonces no habría un estándar de verdad moral ya que cada persona tendría su propio estándar. Comentando las palabras de Génesis 2:16-17: “El Señor Dios mandó al hombre, diciendo: De todo árbol del jardín podrás comer; pero del árbol de la ciencia del bien y del mal no comeréis, porque el día que de él comáis, moriréis”, el Papa San Juan Pablo II afirma que “El Apocalipsis enseña que el poder de decidir lo que es bueno y lo malo no es del hombre, sino sólo de Dios” (VS 35) Nuestra conciencia no determina el bien o el mal, aplica el conocimiento del bien y del mal a acciones particulares.

“Formar la conciencia” se produce conformando el intelecto a las verdades morales que se conocen naturalmente y a las que se revelan divinamente. La Iglesia Católica enseña verdades morales como parte de Su misión de salvar almas ya que, como resultado del pecado y la concupiscencia, nuestra comprensión del bien y del mal puede dañarse y deformarse. La enseñanza moral de la Iglesia es entonces un acto de caridad al señalar el “bien que [debemos] hacer para tener la vida eterna” (Mt. 19:16) y el mal que debemos evitar.




