From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I have written recently about those in the Catholic Church who want to change or “update” the Church’s teaching, whether dogmatic or moral. Hypothetically, if Church teaching were to change it would mean one of two things: either the previous teaching was wrong and the new teaching is correct or that the previous teaching was correct in the past and the new teaching is correct now. Neither of these can be true.

The first case is false because it contends that the Church was wrong in the past. If the Church was wrong then, we have no guarantee it is correct now. Man’s salvation depends on the “the faith once delivered to the saints”, if they didn’t have the correct faith, then they could not be saved (Jude 1:3).

The second case is false because the truth cannot change. If something is true, it is true universally. Adultery is wrong everywhere, in all times and cultures, even if not recognized as so by those living in those times. If truth were to change that would mean that God changes, and God cannot change. “[The earth and the heavens] will perish but you will remain. / They will all wear out like a garment.../But you neither change, nor have an end” (Ps 102:27-8).

We know, however, that the Church’s teaching on matters of faith and morals cannot change. Jesus taught the faith to the Apostles, who in turn handed that faith down to their disciples, who continued to hand it down. Yes, that faith has been further explained, but it remains essentially the same faith.

Throughout history, different Church teachings have been further clarified as errors crept in or when challenged by different heresies – but the teaching remains the same. One example of this is the adoption of the word “Trinity” to describe the reality of Three Persons in One God. This word does not appear in the Bible and was not used by the Apostles. They certainly believed and taught that the One True God is the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, but the word Trinity was introduced later (by the North African theologian Tertullian) and adopted by the Church as an adequate term for the dogma that we believe.

St. Paul defended the unchangeability of the faith, writing to the Galatians that even if he himself “or an angel from heaven, preach a gospel to you besides that which we have preached to you, let him be anathema” (Gal 1:8). The First Vatican Council affirms that not even the Pope can change the Catholic faith: “the Holy Spirit was not promised to the successors of Peter that by His revelation they might make known new doctrine, but that by His assistance they might inviolably keep and faithfully expound the Revelation, the Deposit of Faith, delivered through the Apostles” (*Pastor Aeternus*, ch4).

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

He escrito recientemente sobre aquellos en la Iglesia Católica que quieren cambiar o “actualizar” las enseñanzas de la Iglesia, ya sean dogmáticas o morales. Hipotéticamente, si la enseñanza de la Iglesia cambiara, significaría una de dos cosas: o la enseñanza anterior era incorrecta y la nueva enseñanza es correcta o que la enseñanza anterior era correcta en el pasado y la nueva enseñanza es correcta ahora. Ninguna de estas cosas puede ser cierta.

El primer caso es falso porque sostiene que la Iglesia estuvo equivocada en el pasado. Si la Iglesia estaba equivocada entonces, no tenemos garantía de que esté correcta ahora. La salvación del hombre depende de “la fe una vez dada a los santos”, si no tuvieran la fe correcta, entonces no podrían ser salvos (Judas 1:3).

El segundo caso es falso porque la verdad no puede cambiar. Si algo es verdad, es verdad universalmente. El adulterio es malo en todas partes, en todos los tiempos y en todas las culturas, incluso si no lo reconocen quienes viven en esos tiempos. Si la verdad cambiara, eso significaría que Dios cambia, y Dios no puede cambiar. “[La tierra y los cielos] perecerán, pero vosotros permaneceréis. / Todos se gastarán como un vestido.../Pero tú ni cambias, ni tienes fin” (Sal 102,27-8).

Sin embargo, sabemos que las enseñanzas de la Iglesia sobre cuestiones de fe y moral no pueden cambiar. Jesús enseñó la fe a los Apóstoles, quienes a su vez la transmitieron a sus discípulos, quienes continuaron transmitiéndola. Sí, esa fe ha sido explicada con más detalle, pero sigue siendo esencialmente la misma fe.

A lo largo de la historia, las diferentes enseñanzas de la Iglesia se han aclarado aún más a medida que se fueron introduciendo errores o cuando fueron cuestionadas por diferentes herejías, pero la enseñanza sigue siendo la misma. Un ejemplo de esto es la adopción de la palabra “Trinidad” para describir la realidad de Tres Personas en Un Dios. Esta palabra no aparece en la Biblia y no fue utilizada por los Apóstoles. Ciertamente creían y enseñaban que el Único Dios Verdadero es el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo, pero la palabra Trinidad fue introducida más tarde (por el teólogo norteafricano Tertuliano) y adoptada por la Iglesia como un término adecuado para el dogma que creemos.

San Pablo defendió la inmutabilidad de la fe, escribiendo a los Gálatas que incluso si él mismo “o un ángel del cielo os predicare un evangelio distinto del que nosotros os hemos anunciado, sea anatema” (Gal 1,8). El Concilio Vaticano I afirma que ni siquiera el Papa puede cambiar la fe católica: “el Espíritu Santo no fue prometido a los sucesores de Pedro para que por su revelación dieran a conocer la nueva doctrina, sino para que con su ayuda la guardaran inviolablemente y fielmente. exponer la Revelación, el Depósito de la Fe, entregada a través de los Apóstoles” (Pastor Aeternus, cap.4).

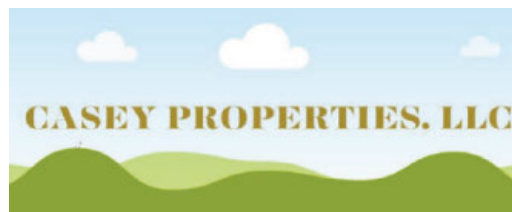

Is Date Night only for St. Theresa Parishioners?


