

Spiritual Theology by Fr. Jordan Aumann, O.P.:
“Means of Spiritual Growth”

The spiritual life, which consists fundamentally in sanctifying grace made operative by the virtue of charity and the other virtues commanded by charity, is a positive, dynamic reality; But the life of grace and charity is received into a human nature wounded by original sin and strongly inclined to self-centered love and the works of the flesh. Therefore, St. Thomas states that “at first it is incumbent on man to occupy himself chiefly with avoiding sin and resisting his concupiscence’s.”

But purgation and mortification are not ends in themselves; they are simply the means of removing the obstacles to the growth of grace and charity. They comprise what St. Paul describes as putting off the old man of Adam and sin, and putting on the new man, Jesus Christ, who is the perfect man. But to put on Christ and to grow in his likeness require the use of positive means by which grace and charity can reach their full expansion and intensity. These positive means can be divided into the three principal ones that are necessary for all Christians -- the **sacraments**, **meritorious good works**, and the **prayer of petition** -- and certain secondary aids to growth in holiness.

It should be noted at the outset that there is a marked difference in the efficacy of the three principal means by which grace and charity are increased. The **sacraments** are the most efficacious, for they produce their effects *ex opere operato*, that is, they infallibly produce grace in those who receive the sacraments with the proper dispositions. The other two means -- meritorious good works and the prayer of petition -- produce their effects *ex opere operantis*, that is, their efficacy depends on the dispositions of the person, working under the impetus of grace and relying on God’s benevolent love.

If we were to arrange these three means in the order of their efficacy, we would list first the sacraments, then meritorious good works, and finally the prayer of petition.

...One normally thinks first of the spiritual and corporal works of mercy or of apostolate and ministry as **good works**, and it is on this basis that many Christians distinguish the active from the contemplative life or love of neighbor from love of God... [However,] the root of merit is charity. Although charity embraces the love of God and neighbor, to love God in himself is more meritorious than to love one's neighbor. Therefore, that which belongs more directly to the love of God is more meritorious on the basis of object than that which belongs to the love of neighbor because of God. Now the contemplative life has direct and immediate reference to the love of God, but the active life is more directly ordained to the love of neighbor. Therefore, in its nature the contemplative life is of greater merit than the active life.

.... When we speak of meritorious good works as a means of growth in grace and holiness, we are referring primarily and essentially not to the external acts of apostolate and ministry, but to the virtues from which those external works proceed.

The reason for this is that the external works are good in the measure that they are directed to a morally good object or end; external works are meritorious in the measure that they proceed from charity, which constitutes the supernatural motivation for the work. Now, it is evident that a person can perform the external work without possessing the supernatural virtue corresponding to that work (as in the case of a person in the state of mortal sin), or a person may perform the action without the necessary interior dispositions (cf. Matt. 6:1). In neither case is the external good work productive of an increase in grace. Therefore, it is necessary to insist that external good works should proceed from the proper interior dispositions and that growth in holiness through meritorious good works applies first and foremost to the operation of the infused virtues [of faith, hope, and charity].

Teología espiritual por el Padre Jordan Aumann, O.P.: “Medios de crecimiento espiritual”

La vida espiritual, que consiste fundamentalmente en la gracia santificante operada por la virtud de la caridad y las demás virtudes mandadas por la caridad, es una realidad positiva y dinámica; Pero la vida de gracia y de caridad es recibida en una naturaleza humana herida por el pecado original y fuertemente inclinada al amor egocéntrico y a las obras de la carne. Por eso, Santo Tomás afirma que “al principio corresponde al hombre ocuparse principalmente de evitar el pecado y resistir sus concupiscencias”.

Pero la purgación y la mortificación no son fines en sí mismas; son simplemente los medios para eliminar los obstáculos al crecimiento de la gracia y la caridad. Comprenden lo que San Pablo describe como despojarse del viejo hombre de Adán y del pecado, y vestirse del nuevo hombre, Jesucristo, que es el hombre perfecto. Pero vestirse de Cristo y crecer a su semejanza requiere el uso de medios positivos mediante los cuales la gracia y la caridad puedan alcanzar su plena expansión e intensidad. Estos medios positivos se pueden dividir en los tres principales que son necesarios para todos los cristianos: los **sacramentos, las buenas obras meritorias y la oración de petición**, y ciertas ayudas secundarias para crecer en la santidad.

Cabe señalar desde el principio que existe una marcada diferencia en la eficacia de los tres medios principales por los cuales se aumentan la gracia y la caridad. Los **sacramentos** son los más eficaces, porque producen sus efectos *ex opere operato*, es decir, infaliblemente producen gracia en quienes reciben los sacramentos con las debidas disposiciones. Los otros dos medios –las buenas obras meritorias y la oración de petición– producen sus efectos *ex opere operantis*, es decir, su eficacia depende de las disposiciones de la persona, actuando bajo el impulso de la gracia y apoyándose en el amor benévolos de Dios.

Si tuviéramos que ordenar estos tres medios en el orden de su eficacia, enumeraríamos primero los sacramentos, luego las buenas obras meritorias y finalmente la oración de petición.

...Normalmente se piensa primero en las obras de misericordia espirituales y corporales o de apostolado y ministerio como **buenas obras**, y es sobre esta base que muchos cristianos distinguen la vida activa de la contemplativa o el amor al prójimo del amor a Dios... [Sin embargo,] la raíz del mérito es la caridad. Aunque la caridad abarca el amor a Dios y al prójimo, amar a Dios en sí mismo es más meritorio que amar al prójimo. Luego lo que pertenece más directamente al amor de Dios es más meritorio por el objeto que lo que pertenece al amor al prójimo por causa de Dios. Ahora bien, la vida contemplativa tiene referencia directa e inmediata al amor de Dios, pero la vida activa está más directamente ordenada al amor al prójimo. Luego, por su naturaleza, la vida contemplativa tiene mayor mérito que la vida activa.

.... Cuando hablamos de buenas obras meritorias como medio de crecimiento en gracia y santidad, nos referimos primaria y esencialmente no a los actos externos de apostolado y ministerio, sino a las virtudes de las cuales proceden esas obras externas.

La razón de esto es que las obras externas son buenas en la medida en que se dirigen a un objeto o fin moralmente bueno; Las obras externas son meritorias en la medida en que proceden de la caridad, que constituye la motivación sobrenatural de la obra. Ahora bien, es evidente que una persona puede realizar la obra exterior sin poseer la virtud sobrenatural correspondiente a esa obra (como en el caso de una persona en estado de pecado mortal), o puede realizar la acción sin las necesarias disposiciones interiores. (cf. Mateo 6:1). En ninguno de los casos la buena obra externa produce un aumento de la gracia. Por tanto, es necesario insistir en que las buenas obras externas deben proceder de las adecuadas disposiciones interiores y que el crecimiento en la santidad mediante buenas obras meritorias se aplica ante todo a la operación de las virtudes infusas [de fe, esperanza y caridad].






