*From the Pastor's Desk*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am pleased to say that all of the necessary permits have been obtained from the City of Sugar Land and construction on our bell tower will begin this week. As a recap for those who missed the previous bulletins where I outlined the project: Aside from its aesthetic value, the bell tower houses several large electrical distribution panels. All the power for the church, school, office, Community Center, and old rectory comes through the base of the tower. That equipment is getting old and needs to be replaced.

We recently had some engineers come and evaluate the tower and they found some corrosion of the interior steel frame structure, and one spot where the steel had been eaten through entirely. This corrosion was caused because the tower itself is not waterproof. When it rains, the water can enter the belfry level, which has an open hatch where the ladder comes up that water can run down. There is an additional flooring layer between that opening and the electrical panels, and thankfully the water has never damaged the equipment at the base.

The construction crews will first have to remove the existing stucco exterior to perform repairs of the existing steel structure. Most of the steel is good, but some will need reinforced or replaced. All the steel will be painted with a zinc, rust resistant paint. When that work is finished, a new exterior will be added back (an artistic rendering is below). The old non-functional carillon system will be removed and replaced with three new brass bells. These bells have already been forged and will be delivered here shortly before being hoisted up and placed in the tower (which should be in early December).

The openings at the top of the tower will be covered with high grade louvers which will unfortunately block the view of the bells, but also prevent water from entering the tower. Towards the end of the construction, the electrical equipment will be replaced. The lead time on that equipment was longer than projected, but the whole project should be completed in about four months.

Several generous parishioners have already contributed to the project and the cost as well as money raised can be found on the following page under a report of our weekly offertory collections. If you would like to donate to help the project, donations can be made online or at the parish office; there are also envelopes in the church that can be used. I am looking forward to hearing the bells and am very grateful for your support.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Me complace decir que se han obtenido todos los permisos necesarios de la Ciudad de Sugar Land y que la construcción de nuestro campanario comenzará esta semana. Como resumen para aquellos que se perdieron los boletines anteriores donde describí el proyecto: Además de su valor estético, el campanario alberga varios grandes paneles de distribución eléctrica. Todo el poder de la iglesia, la escuela, la oficina, el centro comunitario y la antigua rectoría pasa a través de la base de la torre. Ese equipo se está volviendo viejo y necesita ser reemplazado.

Recientemente, algunos ingenieros vinieron y evaluaron la torre y encontraron algo de corrosión en la estructura interior de la estructura de acero y un punto donde el acero se había comido por completo. Esta corrosión se debió a que la torre en sí no es impermeable. Cuando llueve, el agua puede entrar al nivel del campanario, que tiene una trampilla abierta por donde sube una escalera por la que puede bajar el agua. Hay una capa de piso adicional entre esa abertura y los paneles eléctricos y, afortunadamente, el agua nunca ha dañado el equipo en la base.

Los equipos de construcción primero tendrán que quitar el exterior de estuco existente para realizar reparaciones de la estructura de acero existente. La mayor parte del acero es bueno, pero será necesario reforzar o reemplazar parte. Todo el acero irá pintado con pintura zinc resistente a la oxidación. Cuando ese trabajo esté terminado, se agregará un nuevo exterior (a continuación, se muestra una representación artística). El antiguo sistema de carillón que no funciona será retirado y reemplazado por tres nuevas campanas de latón. Estas campanas ya han sido forjadas y serán entregadas aquí poco antes de ser izadas y colocadas en la torre (lo que debería ser a principios de diciembre).

Las aberturas en la parte superior de la torre estarán cubiertas con persianas de alta calidad que desafortunadamente bloquearán la vista de las campanas, pero también impedirán que el agua entre a la torre. Hacia el final de la construcción se procederá a la sustitución del equipamiento eléctrico. El plazo de entrega de ese equipo fue más largo de lo proyectado, pero todo el proyecto debería completarse en unos cuatro meses.

Varios feligreses generosos ya han contribuido al proyecto y el costo y el dinero recaudado se pueden encontrar en la página siguiente, bajo un informe de nuestras colectas de ofertorios semanales. Si desea donar para ayudar al proyecto, puede hacerlo en línea o en la oficina parroquial; También hay sobres en la iglesia que se pueden utilizar. Estoy deseando escuchar las campanas y estoy muy agradecido por su apoyo.

Blessed Carlo Acutis who was born on May 3, 1991, was to die at age 15 on October 12, 2006, from leukemia. During his brief existence on this EARTH, he understood, “TO live with Jesus, for Jesus, and in Jesus.” Soon after his first communion he began attending Mass and praying the Rosary daily. He spent hours in front of the Blessed sacrament and was often heard SAYING, “when we are face to face with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, we become Saints.”

During his life, Blessed Carlo worked to strengthen the faith of those in his life. He designed the Exhibition of the Miracles of the Eucharist that has traveled to many countries and continents. To date, the Exhibition has visited over 5 continents and the website has been viewed throughout the world.
