

Chapter 3. WHAT IS THE INTERIOR LIFE?

EIGHTH TRUTH. My interior life will be no better than my custody of my heart. "Before all things keep a guard over thy heart, for from it springs forth life."—

This custody of the heart is simply a HABITUAL or at least frequent anxiety to preserve all my acts, as they arise, from everything that might spoil their motive or their execution. It is a peaceful, unexcited anxiety, without any trace of strain, yet powerful because it is based on childlike confidence in God.

It is the work of the heart and the will, rather than of the mind, which has to remain free to carry out its duties. Far from being an impediment to activity, the custody of the heart perfects it, by ordering it to the Spirit of God, and adjusting it to the duties of our state of life.

It is an exercise that can be carried on at any hour. It is a quick glance, from the heart, over present actions and a peaceful attention to all the various phases of an action, as we perform it. It is carrying out exactly the precept, "Age quod agis [do what you are doing]." The soul, like an alert sentry, keeps watch over every movement of its heart, over everything that is going on within it: all its impressions, intentions, passions, inclinations; in a word, all its interior and exterior acts, all its thoughts, words, and deeds.

Custody of the heart demands a certain amount of recollection: there is no place for it in a soul given to dissipation.

By frequently following this practice, we will gradually acquire the habit of it. *Quo vadam et ad quid*? Where am I going and why? What would Jesus do? How would He act in my place? What advice would He give me? What does He want from me, at this moment? Such are the questions that spring up spontaneously in the soul that is hungry for interior life.

For the soul that goes to Jesus through Mary, this custody of the heart takes on a still more affectionate quality, and recourse to this dear Mother becomes a continual need for his heart.

ELEVENTH TRUTH. If God calls me to apply my activity not only to my own sanctification, but also to good works, I must establish this firm conviction, before everything else, in my mind: Jesus has got to be, and wishes to be, the life of these works.

My efforts, by themselves, are nothing, absolutely nothing. "Without Me you can do nothing." They will only be useful, and blessed by God, if by means of a genuine interior life I unite them constantly to the life-giving action of Jesus. But then they will become all-powerful: "I can do all things in Him who strengthened me." But should they spring from pride and self-satisfaction, from confidence in my own talents, from the desire to shine, they will be rejected by God: for would it not be a sacrilegious madness for me to steal, from God, a little of His glory in order to decorate and beautify myself?

This conviction, far from robbing me of all initiative, will be my strength. And it will make me really feel the need to pray that I may obtain humility, which is such a treasure for my soul, since it is a guarantee of God's help and of success in my labors.

Capítulo 3. ¿QUÉ ES LA VIDA INTERIOR?

OCTAVA VERDAD. Mi vida interior no será mejor que la custodia de mi corazón. "Ante todo, guarda tu corazón, porque de él brota la vida." —

Esta custodia del corazón es simplemente una ansiedad HABITUAL o al menos frecuente de preservar todos mis actos, tal como surgen, de todo lo que pueda estropear su motivo o su ejecución. Es una ansiedad pacífica, tranquila, sin ningún rastro de tensión, pero poderosa porque se basa en una confianza infantil en Dios.

Es obra del corazón y de la voluntad, más que de la mente, la que debe permanecer libre para cumplir sus deberes. Lejos de ser un impedimento para la actividad, la custodia del corazón la perfecciona, ordenándola al Espíritu de Dios y ajustándola a los deberes de nuestro estado de vida.

Es un ejercicio que se puede realizar a cualquier hora. Es una mirada rápida, desde el corazón, a las acciones presentes y una atención pacífica a las distintas fases de una acción, a medida que la realizamos. Está llevando a cabo exactamente el precepto: "Age quod agis [haz lo que estás haciendo]". El alma, como un centinela alerta, vigila cada movimiento de su corazón, todo lo que en él sucede: todas sus impresiones, intenciones, pasiones, inclinaciones; en una palabra, todos sus actos interiores y exteriores, todos sus pensamientos, palabras y hechos.

La custodia del corazón exige cierto recogimiento: no hay lugar para ello en un alma dada a la disipación.

Siguiendo frecuentemente esta práctica, gradualmente adquiriremos el hábito. *Quo vadam et ad quid*? ¿A dónde voy y por qué? ¿Qué haría Jesús? ¿Cómo actuaría Él en mi lugar? ¿Qué consejo me daría? ¿Qué quiere Él de mí en este momento? Tales son las preguntas que surgen espontáneamente en el alma hambrienta de vida interior.

Para el alma que va a Jesús a través de María, esta custodia del corazón adquiere una cualidad aún más afectuosa, y el recurso a esta querida Madre se convierte en una necesidad continua de su corazón.

UNDÉCIMA VERDAD. Si Dios me llama a aplicar mi actividad no sólo a mi propia santificación, sino también a las buenas obras, debo establecer, ante todo, en mi mente esta firme convicción: Jesús debe ser y quiere ser la vida de estas obras.

Mis esfuerzos, por sí solos, no son nada, absolutamente nada. "Sin Mí no podéis hacer nada". Sólo serán útiles y bendecidos por Dios si, mediante una genuina vida interior, los uno constantemente a la acción vivificante de Jesús. Pero entonces se volverán todopoderosos: "Todo lo puedo en Aquel que me fortaleció". Pero si brotan del orgullo y de la autosatisfacción, de la confianza en mis propios talentos, del deseo de brillar, serán rechazados por Dios: porque ¿no sería una locura sacrílega por mi parte robarle a Dios un poco de ¿Su gloria para adornarme y embellecerme?

Esta convicción, lejos de privarme de toda iniciativa, será mi fuerza. Y me hará sentir realmente la necesidad de orar para obtener la humildad, que es un tesoro para mi alma, ya que es garantía de la ayuda de Dios y del éxito en mis trabajos.

STCS WELCOMES NEW DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR TISH NGUYEN





St. Vincent de Paul – Annual Summary Report

As our fiscal year ended September 30th it's time for us to share an Annual Summary of our St. Theresa SVdP finances and activity. Complicating things this year was a second grant of ARPA government funding (American Rescue Plan Act). As explained in previous bulletins, the Archdiocese of Galveston/Houston Society of St. Vincent de Paul was awarded ARPA funds to help Fort Bend residents facing eviction pay to pay their rent. Our SVdP conference received \$40,000 of these funds in April and May and had depleted them by the end of June. Please note that ARPA funds are treated separately and shown in red in the chart below. They are not included in our Deposit and Expense Totals.

They say, "God's fingerprints are everywhere" and to see the proof of this just look at our 'Total Expenses' for the year which were \$130,350 and our Deposits \$131,976. God always provides us with the volunteers and funding that we need. So, we thank each one of you for caring and giving our Vincentians the opportunity to grow in spirituality by serving the poor and needy in our community on your behalf. We are honored and truly blessed to be allowed to serve.

Este año fue el segundo año de asistencia de ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act), fondos gubernamentales que complicaron un poco las cosas. 
