Pope St. John Paul II,
Homily January 14, 1979

We have listened to the Word of God in today's liturgy, which speaks to us in the text of the book of Samuel, the letter of St Paul to the Corinthians, and the Gospel of St John. Although these texts, which we have heard, are very different, the Word of God of this Sunday speaks to us above all of one question: "vocation", the "call". This is stressed in the description contained in the book of Samuel: God calls a boy by name; He calls him in a perceptible voice, speaking his name. Samuel hears the voice and wakes up from sleep three times, and for three times he fails to understand whose voice it is, who is calling him by name. Only on the fourth time, instructed by Eli, does he give a suitable answer: "Speak, Lord, for thy servant hears" (1S 3,9).


This passage from the book of Samuel enables us to understand more thoroughly the vocation of the first Apostles, of Andrew and Peter called by Jesus Christ. They, too, accept the call, and follow Jesus; first Andrew, who announces to his brother: "We have found the Messiah"; then, in his turn, Simon, to whom Jesus, during their first meeting, announces his new name, "Cephas" ("which means Peter" Jn 1,42) ...

God, who calls man to his service and assigns a task to him, has a fundamental right to do so. He alone has this right because he is the Creator and Redeemer of each of us. If he calls us, if he invites us to follow a given way, he does so in order that we will not dissipate his work; in order that we may respond with our own lives to the gift received from him; in order that we may live in a way worthy of man, who is "a temple of God"; in order that we may be able to carry out that particular duty, which he wishes to entrust to us.

The Parish, which—according to the affirmation of the Second Vatican Council—is "a kind of cell" of the diocese (cf. *Apostolicam Actuositatem AA 10*), is just the environment in which the Christian must hear the call that God addresses to him, accept it and realize it; and he is certainly helped in that by the faith and the life of faith of the whole parish community. A life of faith, which has its beginning in the family, dynamically integrated in the parish, and which develops from Baptism to the meeting with Christ in death; following the principle of the close collaboration between the family and the parish, which cooperate together in the formation of the responsible and mature Christian. Here, therefore, is the indispensable necessity of parish catechesis, which integrates and completes the teaching of religion imparted at school and connects religious knowledge with sacramental life.

Just in this context, each of the parishioners—especially if young—must put to himself responsibly the fundamental question of his own Christian existence: "To what does God call me?". It may be the call to a given profession, which puts one in the service of others and of society, such as being a doctor, a teacher, a lawyer, a professional, a worker ... ; or the vocation to family life, by means of the sacrament of Marriage; or the call, for some, to exclusive service of God, as happened—the Liturgy reminds us today—in the case of Samuel, Andrew, and Simon. But the whole life of a man and a Christian, the fruit of the infinite love of God the Father, is a "vocation" which embraces the different stages of existence, and gives a meaning to the various situations, even to suffering, illness, old age. The Christian must always, and in all circumstances, be able to repeat, with faith and with conviction, the words of the young Samuel: "Speak, Lord, for thy servant hears" (1 Sam 3:9).

I would like this moving and generous readiness to accept God's call to be always present in all the many faithful of this parish, to form a living Christian community, joyful and proud to be able to say "yes" to Christ and to the Church.

Papa San Juan Pablo II, Homilía 14 de enero de 1979

Hemos escuchado la Palabra de Dios en la liturgia de hoy, que nos habla en el texto del libro de Samuel, en la carta de san Pablo a los Corintios y en el Evangelio de san Juan. Aunque estos textos que hemos escuchado sean muy diferentes, la Palabra de Dios de este domingo nos habla sobre todo de una cuestión: la "vocación", la "llamada". Esto se destaca en la descripción contenida en el libro de Samuel: Dios llama a un niño por su nombre; Lo llama con voz perceptible, pronunciando su nombre. Samuel oye la voz y se despierta tres veces del sueño, y por tres veces no entiende de quién es la voz que lo llama por su nombre. Sólo la cuarta vez, instruido por Elí, da una respuesta adecuada: "Habla, Señor, que tu siervo oye" (1S 3,9).

Este pasaje del libro de Samuel nos permite comprender más profundamente la vocación de los primeros Apóstoles, de Andrés y de Pedro, llamados por Jesucristo. Ellos también aceptan el llamado y siguen a Jesús; primero Andrés, que anuncia a su hermano: "Hemos encontrado al Mesías"; luego, a su vez, Simón, a quien Jesús, durante el primer encuentro, anuncia su nuevo nombre, "Cefas" ("que significa Pedro" Jn 1,42) ...

Dios, que llama al hombre a su servicio y le asigna una tarea, tiene un derecho fundamental a hacerlo. Sólo Él tiene este derecho porque es el Creador y Redentor de cada uno de nosotros. Si nos llama, si nos invita a seguir un camino determinado, lo hace para que no disipemos su obra; para que respondamos con la propia vida al don recibido de él; para que vivamos de manera digna del hombre, que es "templo de Dios"; para que podamos llevar a cabo ese deber particular que él desea confiarinos.

La parroquia, que –según la afirmación del Concilio Vaticano II– es "una especie de célula" de la diócesis (cf. Apostolicam Actuositatem AA 10), es precisamente el ambiente en el que el cristiano debe escuchar la llamada que Dios le dirige. él, acéptalo y date cuenta; y en ello ciertamente le ayuda la fe y la vida de fe de toda la comunidad parroquial. Una vida de fe, que tiene su inicio en la familia, integrada dinámicamente en la parroquia, y que se desarrolla desde el bautismo hasta el encuentro con Cristo en la muerte; siguiendo el principio de la estrecha colaboración entre la familia y la parroquia, que cooperan juntas en la formación del cristiano responsable y maduro. He aquí, por tanto, la necesidad indispensable de una catequesis parroquial, que integre y complete la enseñanza de la religión impartida en la escuela y conecte el conocimiento religioso con la vida sacramental.

Precisamente en este contexto, cada uno de los feligreses –especialmente los jóvenes– debe plantearse responsablemente la pregunta fundamental de su propia existencia cristiana: "¿A qué me llama Dios?". Puede ser la llamada a una determinada profesión, que lo pone al servicio de los demás y de la sociedad, como ser médico, docente, abogado, profesional, trabajador...; o la vocación a la vida familiar, mediante el sacramento del Matrimonio; o la llamada, para algunos, al servicio exclusivo de Dios, como ocurrió –nos lo recuerda hoy la Liturgia– en el caso de Samuel, Andrés y Simón. Pero toda la vida del hombre y del cristiano, fruto del amor infinito de Dios Padre, es una "vocación" que abarca las diferentes etapas de la existencia y da sentido a las diversas situaciones, incluso al sufrimiento, la enfermedad, vejez. El cristiano debe poder repetir siempre y en todas las circunstancias, con fe y convicción, las palabras del joven Samuel: "Habla, Señor, que tu siervo oye" (1 Sam 3, 9).

Quisiera que esta commovedora y generosa disposición a acoger la llamada de Dios esté siempre presente en todos los numerosos fieles de esta parroquia, para formar una comunidad cristiana viva, alegre y orgullosa de poder decir "sí" a Cristo y a la Iglesia.




Padre Pio: Between Heaven and Earth


