*From the Pastor's Desk*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the Creed, we profess our belief that the Church is One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic. These four characteristics are known as the “marks” of the Church and are used to identify the true Church of Jesus Christ.

The Church Jesus established must be One. Jesus spoke of one sheepfold and one shepherd (Jn 10:16), He appointed one man (St. Peter) as the head of the church (Mt 16:18), and He left one united doctrine that was to be taught and believed (Mt 28:20). A unity in the faith and governance is essential to the Church and makes up almost the entire definition given in the Baltimore Catechism to the question “What is the Church?” which answers that “[t]he Church is the congregation of all those who profess the faith of Christ, partake of the same Sacraments, and are governed by their lawful pastors under one visible Head” (Q489).

In the Creed, however, we also profess that the Church is also Catholic and Apostolic. The Church established by Jesus must be Catholic, by which we mean universal or spread throughout the world. Jesus made clear that He intended His disciples to preach to all nations (Mt 28:19) and “even to the ends of the earth” (Acts 1:9). A church which is not spread throughout the world cannot be the Church established and willed by Jesus.

The Church is Apostolic because Jesus selected chosen men as Apostles to form the foundation of the Church (Mt 19:28; Rev 21:14). The true Church will be of Apostolic origins with a visible succession back to the first Apostles. In the Catholic Church we have a visible succession of pastors (the Pope and bishops) going all the way back to the Apostles. Some Orthodox churches are also able to claim apostolic succession, however, since they have separated themselves from the unity of the Church, they are not able to claim true catholicity or unity (oneness).

I skipped over the mark of “Holy” because this is perhaps the biggest stumbling block for many people. Certainly, the Church established by Jesus must be holy and yet we see a lot of people in the Church who are not living uprightly. Jesus spoke of the presence of the wheat and the tares together in the Church until the harvest time (Mt 13:24-43). He also chose as an Apostle one whom He knew would betray Him and so we should not be scandalized by the personal conduct of any particular member of the Church.

The Baltimore Catechism says that the Church is holy “because its founder, Jesus Christ, is holy; because it teaches a holy doctrine; invites all to a holy life; and because of the eminent holiness of so many thousands of its children” (Q 563). We can also add that the Church is holy because it offers the means for attaining holiness in its teaching, disciples, and Sacraments (cf. Eph 5:26-27). The holiness of the lives of the saints throughout the centuries is a strong sign of the holiness of the Church whose teaching was their inspiration and whose Sacraments were their support.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En el Credo profesamos nuestra creencia de que la Iglesia es Una, Santa, Católica y Apostólica. Estas cuatro características se conocen como las “marcas” de la Iglesia y se utilizan para identificar la verdadera Iglesia de Jesucristo.

La Iglesia que Jesús estableció debe ser Una. Jesús habló de un redil y un pastor (Jn 10:16), nombró a un hombre (San Pedro) como cabeza de la iglesia (Mt 16:18) y dejó una doctrina unida que debía ser enseñada y creída. (Mt 28:20). La unidad en la fe y el gobierno es esencial para la Iglesia y constituye casi toda la definición dada en el Catecismo de Baltimore a la pregunta “¿Qué es la Iglesia?” lo que responde que “[l]a Iglesia es la congregación de todos aquellos que profesan la fe de Cristo, participan de los mismos Sacramentos y son gobernados por sus legítimos pastores bajo una sola Cabeza visible” (Q489).

En el Credo, sin embargo, también profesamos que la Iglesia es también católica y apostólica. La Iglesia establecida por Jesús debe ser católica, es decir, universal o extendida por todo el mundo. Jesús dejó en claro que tenía la intención de que sus discípulos predicasen en todas las naciones (Mt 28:19) y “hasta los confines de la tierra” (Hechos 1:9). Una Iglesia que no esté extendida por el mundo no puede ser la Iglesia establecida y querida por Jesús.

La Iglesia es Apostólica porque Jesús seleccionó a hombres escogidos como Apóstoles para formar el fundamento de la Iglesia (Mt 19:28; Ap 21:14). La verdadera Iglesia será de orígenes apostólicos con una sucesión visible hasta los primeros Apóstoles. En la Iglesia Católica tenemos una sucesión visible de pastores (el Papa y los obispos) que se remonta a los Apóstoles. Algunas iglesias ortodoxas también pueden reclamar la sucesión apostólica; sin embargo, dado que se han separado de la unidad de la Iglesia, no pueden reclamar una verdadera catolicidad o unidad.

Me salté la marca de “Santo” porque este es quizás el mayor obstáculo para muchas personas. Ciertamente, la Iglesia establecida por Jesús debe ser santa y, sin embargo, vemos a muchas personas en la Iglesia que no viven rectamente. Jesús habló de la presencia del trigo y la cizaña juntos en la Iglesia hasta el tiempo de la cosecha (Mt 13,24-43). También eligió como Apóstol a alguien que sabía que lo traicionaría y por eso no debemos scandalizarnos por la conducta personal de ningún miembro de la Iglesia en particular.

El Catecismo de Baltimore dice que la Iglesia es santa “porque su fundador, Jesucristo, es santo; porque enseña una santa doctrina; invita a todos a una vida santa; y por la eminente santidad de tantos miles de sus hijos” (P 563). También podemos añadir que la Iglesia es santa porque ofrece los medios para alcanzar la santidad en su enseñanza, en sus discípulos y en sus sacramentos (cf. Ef 5, 26-27). La santidad de la vida de los santos a lo largo de los siglos es un fuerte signo de la santidad de la Iglesia cuyas enseñanzas fueron su inspiración y cuyos Sacramentos fueron su apoyo.






